PAINTING DAY

Students will check in at Cousino on painting day and submit their design/sketch for approval prior to painting. Once the design is approved a spot will be assigned and they may start the process of painting their spot.

Supplies to bring on Painting Day:

<u>Water Based Exterior Latex Paint</u> – This type of paint can be found at any home improvement or hardware store. Check the clearance section for deeply discounted unique colors! You may want to consider coordinating colors with your friends in order to share paint. Don't forget to check your garage or basement for paint you already have. You will be painting over last year's parking spots and will need a base color to ensure last year's design doesn't show through on yours.

<u>Chalk, Painters Tape, Broom/Dustpan</u> – You will need to sweep your spot before you begin to ensure it is free of debris and rock. Chalk and tape will be helpful in drawing out your design and sectioning off your spot.

<u>Brushes, Rollers, Paint Pans</u> – Check the dollar stores and craft supply places for these items as they tend to be less expensive.

<u>Drop Cloth, Old Towels/Rage, Garbage Bags</u> – You will need these to put your paint cans on and to help with clean up.

Please make sure to dress for the weather and don't forget water, snacks, sunscreen, lawn chairs, etc.
